Lillian suggests a duplicate invite to indicate that an RSVP to Bernie & Nancy is needed for this combined party. Bernie would like two boats for seating at his pier and he needs chairs. There is also enough money to buy prizes. We will meet in mid-June to discuss costs.

The fourth and final Event is the Fall Square Dance and buffet dinner to be held at the Fuzzy Pig Barn. The cost for the Barn is only \$300 and the cost for the caller is \$150. Pat, Judy and Elaine will meet next week with the Chef and Pam Kraus at the Kraus Hous. We will then know our costs for food. The Pig will also set up a bar and we will try to determine what we need for decorations.

It was decided to drop the idea for a Warhawks Tailgate. We have been rained out two years in a row and have lost interest. Also, our organizer, Lynn Carter will be gone this Fall.
